## Khwai & Nxai Pan Botswana Safari

Min 2 passengers / Max 8 passengers | 6 nights' luxury camping



Begin this 9-day luxury camping safari to Botswana by exploring the often underrated but fascinating Nxai Pan National Park in the Kalahari. During the country's rainy season (Nov-Apr), nutritious grasses and desert flowers break through sandy, dry soils attracting small migrations of plains game – notably zebra. This is when Nxai Pan comes alive with herds of grazing animals followed closely by their predators such as cheetah and black-maned lions. Combine this incredible wildlife spectacle with time exploring the productive Khwai reserve, game driving along the outer reaches of the Okavango Delta's lily-filled waterways and through riverine woodland beside the Khwai River. You'll be led by expert guides throughout and stay in intimate luxury mobile camps.

## Exclusive Kalahari & Okavango Safari

Combine exploration of the less-visited Central Kalahari Game Reserve with time in the lush Okavango Delta paradise on this 10-day exclusive camping holiday. We recommend travelling on this safari between March and the end of April, as this is when the Central Kalahari becomes one of the prime game-viewing areas in Botswana. The usually dry desert turns verdant and green from the recent summer rains, and the flat grasslands often teem with thousands of gemsbok and springbok searching out the nutritious grasses. This in turn attracts predators to the area, especially cheetah and the Kalahari's famous black-maned lions; there's also an excellent chance of seeing a pack of wild dogs hunting.

## Moremi, Chobe & Victoria Falls Adventure

This 13-day camping safari covers many of Botswana's northern highlights. Although you sleep on comfortable mattresses in spacious canvas dome tents, it's a little more basic than many of the other safaris we offer to Botswana, with shared ablutions and drinks at an additional cost. That's where the differences end; you still travel in good 4WD safari vehicles and into many of the country's best wildlife areas, led by a professional and knowledgeable guide. Begin with a scenic flight before game driving your way through the wildlife-rich Moremi, Savuti and Chobe reserves, including the chance to explore the Okavango Delta by boat. End with a night overlooking the Zambezi River, near the spectacular Victoria Falls.

All this is topped off with a visit to the spectacular Victoria Falls.
