Southern Namibia Desert Adventure

All camping equipment is provided, including easy-erecting dome tents and sleeping bags, on this 11-day simple camping adventure. It's a varied trip that explores Namibia's most spectacular desert scenery. You'll wander through an unusual forest of giant aloe trees, and walk along the rim of one of the world's largest canyons before visiting a Nama cultural initiative to learn a little of local traditions. On the way to the sleepy, historic town of Lüderitz, you'll see the world's only wild desert horses, and you'll experience the eerie Kolmanskop, a deserted diamond boomtown now inhabited only by ghosts. Finally, you'll watch the sun rise and set over the world's tallest dunes, before climbing them yourself at Sossusvlei.

The second is a shorter safari to Etosha National Park where you will marvel at the abundant wildlife and see the vast salt pan. You'll stay in easy to erect dome tents in desert and semi-desert areas when you visit the Fish River Canyon and Namib-Naukluft National Park. Then, in Etosha, it's easy to spot the big animals, though travelling with a knowledgeable guide allows you to understand and appreciate the smaller species too. There are insights to local Namibian culture dotted throughout, with visits to Windhoek's townships, historic Lüderitz and a Nama cultural initiative.
